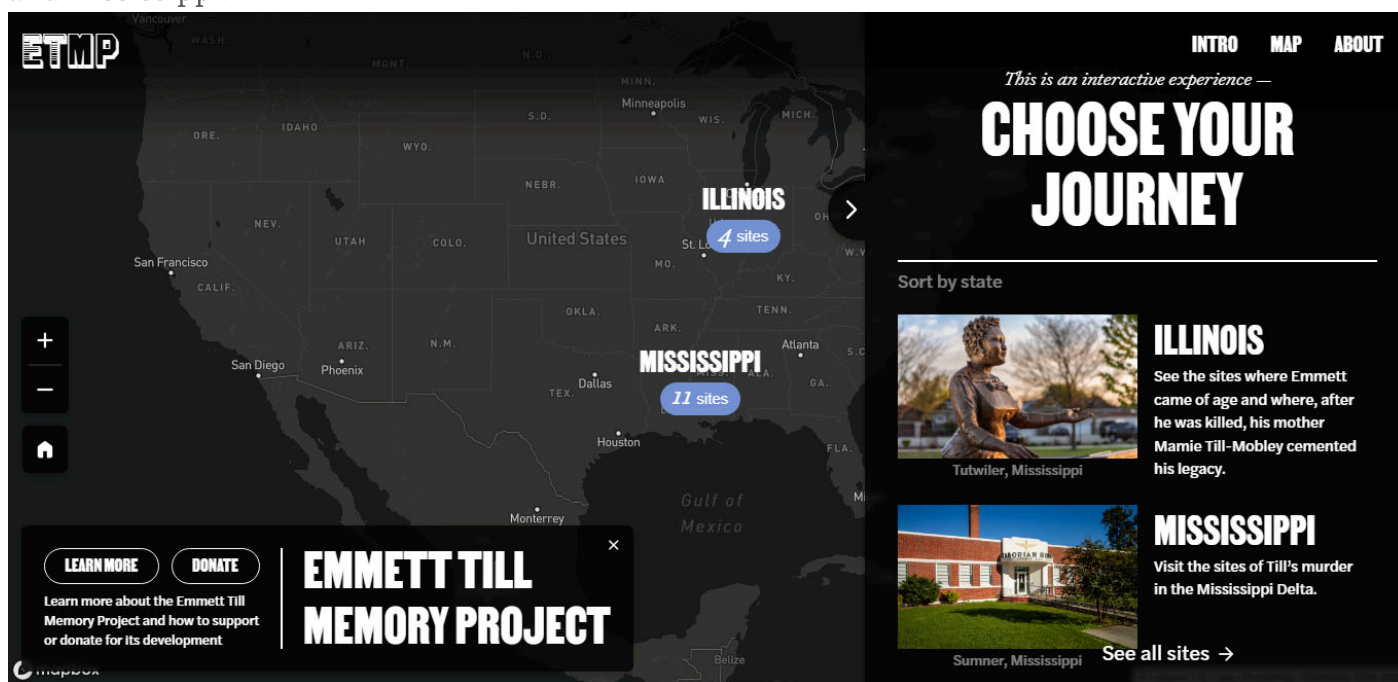




New Design of the Emmett Till Memory Project Launches in Honor of Till Monument's One-Year Anniversary

The [Emmett Till Memory Project \(ETMP\)](#), a website and mobile application touring visitors through sites of the Emmett Till story, launched a new version of the site today, in honor of what would have been Emmett's 83rd birthday. It is also the one-year anniversary of the Emmett Till and Mamie Till-Mobley National Monument designation. The Emmett Till Interpretive Center and [The Emmett Till & Mamie Till-Mobley Institute](#) partnered on the project with Dr. Dave Tell of the University of Kansas and design firm [included by FAVOR](#).

This newly imagined version of the ETMP offers visitors an immersive, media-rich educational experience. The site preserves and protects the Till story, taking people to the sites around Emmett's life and death. This iteration includes never-before-heard oral histories and interviews with the Till family, expert-vetted narratives, archival documents, and immersive renderings of 15 sites in Illinois and Mississippi.



“The more America wrestles with issues of racial justice, the more it returns to the story of Emmett Till,” said Dr. Tell. “It has been the defining honor of my career—if not my life—to work alongside

members of the Till family, the Emmett Till Interpretive Center, and included by FAVOR, to create a resource that tells the true story of the life and death of Emmett Till.”

“This project is not just about the past but also about the future,” said Rene Payne, included by FAVOR's founder and director. “We believe that our rich web experience will empower and educate future generations to dismantle systemic racism and actively create positive, meaningful change.”

We're grateful to the National Park Service's support of this iteration of the ETMP. We hope this website provides people with a new way to experience the Till story that motivates change in our communities.
